GETTING STARTED

- 1. How would you describe what generosity is to someone?
- What stood out to you/ challenged you from the message this week?

REFLECTING ON THE MESSAGE

Key Scriptures: Ruth 2:1-16; Leviticus 19:9-10

Read Ruth 2:1-3 & Leviticus 19:9-10

- 1. What do we learn about generosity from these two passages?
 - a. What are some of the dangers that come from relying on the law as our only form of generosity?
- 2. What would it look like for us to "not harvest the edges of our fields" today? What are our fields?

Read Ruth 2:4-16

- 3. What are some of the examples of generosity that Boaz demonstrates towards Ruth?
- 4. What could it look like to make **generosity personal** here in Alice Springs?
- 5. What could it look like to give people dignity through our generosity?

RESPONDING TO THE MESSAGE

- 1. Can you think of an example in which you have demonstrated generosity well? What did it look like?
- 2. What would it look like for you to develop greater levels of generosity?
- 3. What is your next step in developing generosity? What will it look like?
 - a. To develop habits through the law?
 - b. To Make it personal?
 - c. To give dignity to others?
