  - a. What was it, and why did it capture your attention?

## REFLECTING ON THE MESSAGE

Key Scriptures: Mark 3:7-10; Mark 3:13-19 (Read Mark 3:7-10)

- 1. What can we learn from this passage about the **effect** of the Kingdom of God when it is shared?
- 2. What are some examples you have heard / seen where the attractiveness of the Kingdom of God is evident?
- 3. What characteristic makes **you** attractive as a follower of Jesus in your workplace, home or community group?

(Read Mark 3:13-19)

- 4. What is the importance of what Jesus does in this passage?
- 5. What are some examples of what empowering others looks like in our context?
- 6. Who in your own story encourages and empowered you in a significant way?
- 7. How can you be this kind of person to someone else?
