
WHERE THERE IS DIVERSITY THERE WILL BE DISAGREEMENT

ROMANS 14:1-2

¹ Accept the one whose faith is *weak*, without quarreling over disputable matters. ² One person's faith allows them to eat anything, but another, whose faith is *weak*, eats only vegetables.

DANIEL 1:8, 12 Daniel in Babylon

⁸ But Daniel resolved not to defile himself with the royal food and wine, and he asked the chief official for permission not to defile himself this way.

¹² "Please test your servants for ten days: Give us nothing but vegetables to eat and water to drink."

ROMANS 14:3-4

³The one who eats everything must not treat with contempt the one who does not, and the one who does not eat everything must not judge the one who does, for God has accepted them. ⁴Who are you to judge someone else's servant? To their own master, servants stand or fall. And they will stand, for the Lord is able to make them stand.



ROMANS 14:5-8

⁵ One person considers one day more sacred than another; another considers every day alike. Each of them should be fully convinced in their own mind.⁶ Whoever regards one day as special does so to the Lord. Whoever eats meat does so to the Lord, for they give thanks to God; and whoever abstains does so to the Lord and gives thanks to God.



ON DISPUTABLE MATTERS WE DO WHAT WE DO TO HONOUR GOD

ROMANS 14:10-12

- ¹⁰ For we will all stand before God's judgment seat. ¹¹ It is written:
- "As surely as I live,' says the Lord, 'every knee will bow before me; every tongue will acknowledge God." [Isaiah 45:23]
- ¹² So then, each of us will give an account of ourselves to God.



ROMANS 14:13-15

¹³ Therefore let us stop passing judgment on one another. Instead, make up your mind not to put any stumbling block or obstacle in the way of a brother or sister. ¹⁴ I am convinced, being fully persuaded in the Lord Jesus, that nothing is unclean in itself. But if anyone regards something as unclean, then for that person it is unclean. ¹⁵ If your brother or sister is distressed because of what you eat, you are no longer acting in love.



ON DISPUTABLE MATTERS LOVE IS THE PRIORITY OF PRACTICE

ROMANS 14:19-21

¹⁹ Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to *mutual edification*.

²⁰ Do not destroy the work of God for the sake of food. All food is clean, but it is wrong for a person to eat anything that causes someone else to stumble. ²¹ It is better not to eat meat or drink wine or to do anything else that will cause your brother or sister to fall.
