John 15:5-8

⁵ "I am the vine; you are the branches. **If you** remain in me and I in you, you will bear much **fruit**; apart from me you can do nothing. ⁶ If you do not remain in me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. ⁷ If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. ⁸ This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.



John 15:12-17

¹² My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. ¹³ Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. ¹⁴ You are my friends if you do what I command. ¹⁵ I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you. ¹⁶ You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear **fruit—fruit that will last—**and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you. ¹⁷ This is my command: Love each other.




The fruit that Jesus speaks of is not primarily quantitative but qualitative.


Galatians 5:13-23 (excerpts)
